Chief, Epidemiology and Analysis Division, UNAIDS

Since 1999, Peter Ghys has worked in a number of positions at UNAIDS focusing on the analysis of the AIDS epidemic. He currently holds the post of Chief, Epidemiology and Analysis Division. The Division's main tasks include the development of methods and tools for epidemiological analysis, training and support for country-based epidemiologists in the analysis of levels and trends in the AIDS epidemic, and regular reporting of assessments of the status of country, regional and global AIDS epidemics.

From 1992 until 1999, he directed the Sexually Transmitted Diseases section of Project RETRO-CI, a Côte d'Ivoire-based AIDS research collaboration of the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Côte d'Ivoire's Ministry of Health. Dr Ghys is a physician and epidemiologist and a graduate of universities in the UK and Belgium. He also holds a doctorate in medical sciences from the University of Antwerp.
